Out With The Old & In With The New!

In the Amplified version of the bible, Jesus says in Mathew 28:19-20 ... “Go then and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰Teaching them to observe everything that I have commanded you, and behold, I am with you all the days (perpetually, uniformly, and on every occasion), to the [very] close and consummation of the age. Amen (so let it be).”

He also says in Mark 16:15-18 ... ¹⁵... “Go into all the world and preach and publish openly the good news (the Gospel) to every creature [of the whole human race]. ¹⁶He who believes [who adheres to and trusts in and relies on the Gospel and Him Whom it sets forth] and is baptized will be saved [from the penalty of eternal death]; but he who does not believe [who does not adhere to and trust in and rely on the Gospel and Him Whom it sets forth] will be condemned. ¹⁷And these attesting signs will accompany those who believe: in My name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new languages; ¹⁸They will pick up serpents; and [even] if they drink anything deadly, it will not hurt them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will get well.

I am so excited about what God is doing at New Covenant Church! We have just completed a congregational season of 21 days of prayer and fasting. I believe that the Lord is pleased with our level of seriousness for His will to be accomplished in our lives. In January I preached a message entitled “Out with the old and in with the new”. A comparison was made between a battleship and a cruise ship like what Royal Caribbean or Disney provides families and folks looking to get away and take a short vacation. Many churches today attempt to cater and offer a fancy version of religious entertainment that provides for little anointing and kingdom fruitfulness. With this cruise ship mentality it’s all about being attractive to draw in the world. Sadly it’s another form of empty religion.

NCC is to be a battleship. Battleships aren’t for the weak at heart. Battleships don’t avoid storms and are well prepared to face adversity no matter who the enemy is. We must remember that “we wrestle not against flesh and blood...” This is our year as a family and the militant church to take our region for Jesus Christ. Jesus has given us the Great Commission and we must respond with “yes Lord! Count us in!” Be encouraged in knowing that He is giving us strategy to know how to reach the lost and win them into the Kingdom of God and out of the clutches of Satan.





We have no time to waste. Each day someone dies and goes to hell in our area. There are scores of thousands living well within a driving radius that need what we have! We must respond. You are invited to consider being a missionary and a discipler in your neighborhood. I'm believing that this year I will personally win 100 people to the Lord. This is a bold endeavor. supernatural. God is alive and is on the move in our cities. We must step in and be. I want to challenge you to get a prayer partner and pray weekly with them. Also, commit to reading the bible through this year. I believe that when you spend time in your prayer closet and in His presence daily there's nothing you won't do for His Kingdom as you walk in holiness.

May this be the best year for seeing the lost saved that NCC has ever had! Truly the best is yet to come. Will you step up and look ahead and not look back to yesteryear? Let's declare "I won't go back to the way it used to be before His presence came and changed me!" 2012 Can be our year for God's miraculous to be manifested in our presence. It's conditional on whether or not you will get on board with what He is doing! Let's exchange the cruise ship mentality for the battleship and let's move into the enemy's territory and snatch some souls out of the hellish clutches of Satan! I'm positioned to be used by Him and I know many here are too. Will you join the majority who are saying yes Lord, count me in!?

We have a special kind of mission trip coming together for this spring. There is a small community in the mountains of Honduras, not accessible by vehicle, that we have an opportunity to minister to - a house church there needs some basic Christian teaching. This would not be a "construction type" trip like we have typically done in the past, but a ministering trip to do some basic teaching, specifically for men and women.

The team will likely be small – probably about 8 people – and will involve camping out at the site for at least 3 days (tents and sleeping bags). The team will have to walk in (actually down) and back out (supplies go in by horseback). Those taking the trip will need to be in reasonably good physical condition. It's a steep climb down and then back up.

Dates for the trip are March 21st through March 28th. Steve Dodson will be leading the team. Although this trip might not be for everyone, if God is calling you to go, this will truly be an adventure with Him!

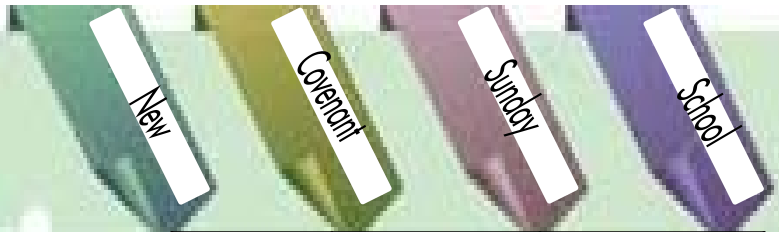
