# Taking Care Of The Temple Of The Holy Spirit

## 4 Reasons Why God Wants Us Healthy, Well & Fit...

1. **It glorifies God.** The Bible says in 1 Corinthians 10:31 that whatever we do we're to do it to the glory of God. It also tells us in Isaiah that we were created and formed by God to glorify Him. This is our primary purpose in life – to glorify God. We do that when we care for our body and live a healthy lifestyle.
2. **Our body is God's Temple and for us to care for.** One scripture that reminds us that our body is God's temple is 1 Corinthians 6:19-20. God's Holy Spirit lives inside a believer. After we accept Jesus into heart, God gives us His Spirit to help us live the kind of life He wants us to live. Since God actually lives in us, Paul tells us in this verse that our body is His temple.

Since God "bought" us with a high price, through Jesus' death, then we are obligated to care for our body which is His temple.

3. **Being healthy is being a good witness.** Acts 1:8 reminds us that we are to be witnesses for other

people. People look for us to be models of the Christian faith. We ought to desire to live our lives in a way that represents our faith well. Taking care of our health is one way that we can be a good witness.

4. **You'll have more energy to do God's work.** Ephesians 2:10 helps us see that we are God's masterpiece, created to do the good things that He had planned a long time ago for us to do. We all know that the more fit and healthy we are the more energy we will have.

The more energy that we have, the more we can put into whatever task we are doing. We'll also be better able to sustain yourself for the long haul.
