## 4 Key Elements of Prayer...

- P** Praise Him for what He's done in your life! Lift up a shout!

- A** Ask on behalf of others before making requests for yourself.
- Y** Yield. The truest form of worship is to live a yielded life. In other words, your behavior lines up with God's Word. Obedience is the key!
