



Respond or React?

I recently saw something that I thought was really good in terms of how we can respond to challenges or problems in our lives. Consider the following and realize that while you may not be able to tackle all of this right off of the bat, by simply getting started and pacing yourself, you will be able to achieve much of this in no time with Holy Spirit's help.

When we consider problems and trials, we have two ways that we can behave. The first option is to react. Most of the time when we do this it may not necessarily be a godly reaction as much as a fleshly reaction. The second option is to respond. The difference between a reaction and a response is that a response is thought out, calculated. Risks and outcomes are factored into our response. I would also say that with a godly response, prayer time should be provided to hear from The Lord in how we might do this.

Let's consider the following for reflection...

- 1) What can I do to go the extra mile to solve this problem / challenge? Going The Extra Mile
- 2) What can I do that I really don't want to do to solve this problem / challenge? Humility
- 3) What can I do that others haven't done to solve this challenge / problem? Setting The Example
- 4) What is something courageous I can do to solve the challenge / problem? Avoiding discouragement
- 5) What is something I can focus on to keep from being distracted? Being Focused
- 6) What are some small things I can do to solve this challenge / problem? Being Attentive To Details
- 7) What can I be thankful for in this situation that can help solve this challenge / problem? Being Grateful!

When we incorporate the Bible, prayer, godly advice, humility, thankfulness, etc., we will find ourselves responding in a victorious and godly manner that will glorify Jesus and move us closer to Him! It's a choice we all get to make... respond or react. It's your move!
