“Being a House Of Prayer”

Next to reading your Bible, there isn’t another spiritual discipline more important than prayer. Don’t get me wrong, there are a great many disciplines that we should participate in as Jesus followers. THE 7 MOUNTAINS

September 2018

Prayer Point: For believers to use their God-given influence to transform the 7 Mountains of our culture

People of influence have the ability to produce change in someone, something, or some area of their life. Every believer has been equipped by God with His Holy Spirit who provides us with the power to bring about “**godly change**” in our environment or sphere of influence. As a result, believers are also known as the 7 Mountain Kingdom “Influencers”. In addition to prayer, this can be done by implementing righteous strategies, ideas, etc. that will transform the areas of our society for the Kingdom of God.

Christians are the salt of the earth and the light of the world (Matthew 5: 13-14). Therefore, the Divine Shift that needs to take place in each of the 7 Mountains will come through believers who have been anointed and appointed by God to impact a particular section of our culture. We are all affected by the 7 Mountains in one way or another. Everyone has a family member, friend, or neighbor (**The Mountain of Family**) they can “influence” for God’s Kingdom. We are a nation of laws and have the opportunity to elect our political leaders by voting (**The Mountain of Government**).
