

Pastor Dave's Page

I've been considering something for a few weeks now and want to share with you what's been on my heart related to God's Word, God's will and God's ways.

Listen to the Hebrews writer with me in Hebrews 4:12-13 (MSG)...

¹²⁻¹³ "God means what he says. What he says goes. His powerful Word is sharp as a surgeon's scalpel, cutting through everything, whether doubt or defense, laying us open to listen and obey. Nothing and no one is impervious to God's Word. We can't get away from it—no matter what." The Message translation really brings this home for us. We've heard how sharp the Bible is. Have you considered that it's as sharp as a scalpel capable of cutting through "everything"?

It's important to choose the right tool for the job. If you want to clean a scratch on the surface of your skin, a cotton ball will do. If you want to remove a small splinter that is barely under the skin, then tweezers might be a good option. But if you want to reach deep inside where your most valuable desires, dreams and decisions are formed – there is only one tool for the job. The scalpel that can penetrate all the way to the heart is Scripture. 2 Timothy 3:16 tells us that Scripture is not just wise words, but words from God. These words are Powerful, Piercing, Penetrating and Probing. It's exactly what we need for change to happen in places that nothing else can touch.

God's Word is the right tool to work on our hearts.

But as powerful as the Scalpel of Scripture is, if we don't allow the Master Surgeon to use it in our lives, we will never experience the health and life and that God wants for us.



Notes From Pastor Dave's Sermon:

- *More than 60% US men are fathers*
- *Fathers in the US tend to be better educated than men without children, and relatively few men have children over 40.*
- *About three-quarters of fathers are married and almost 13% of dads are divorced and 8% have never been married.*
- *Men with children tended to be more educated than those without kids, although the report noted that may be the result of age since the chances of becoming fathers and reaching higher education levels increases with age.*

It's been said that it's much easier to become a father than to be one.

Think back to your childhood and consider the way you were raised and the impact your dad made on your life.

If you teach your kids nothing else, show them the way to God.

It's your job as a parent to live out your faith. Godly dads are committed to seeing God's Word, will and ways activated in his children's life.

"Train up a child in the way he should go [teaching him to seek God's wisdom and will for his abilities and talents], Even when he is old he will not depart from it.
