# Pastor Dave's Pen

Sunday's Message: It's Time To Armor Up!

I've always said that prevention is so much better than intervention. Anytime we can prepare and be prepared for spiritual attacks, the outcome is usually much better than when we're ready. Being equipped and trained is vital for all of us to overcome the works of the enemy. The Apostle Paul has a lot to say about this very important subject.

Sunday, we looked at several verses including Ephesians 6:11-18. Right off the bat, the Apostle Paul says "Put on God's whole armor". I'm reminded how as with anything we wear, we always have choices. The spiritual armor that he mentions contains the keys to overcoming and with each of these pieces we always have a choice. Paul also gives us in the same verse, the purpose of wearing the armor. Catch this... he says "that you may be able successfully to stand up against [all] the strategies and the deceits of the devil" Ephes. 6:11 AMP. The Lord is so good to give us the equipment (armor) to not just fight but win the battle against the enemy.

Dress for success! The whole armor includes the belt of truth which all of the rest of the armor hangs on. Shoes of the preparation of the Gospel of peace. The shield of faith. The helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit. "Putting on" each of the elements of the armor is key to success. He doesn't stop there! He goes on to encourage us to

"pray at all times in the Spirit..." and remember to remain alert, watchful, and purposeful while not neglecting to pray for each other.

Satan is always firing his hot arrows at us. He is always trying to get inside of us with guilt, or accusations. If you have the shield of faith protecting you, Christ is more that able to give you the peace and protection you need. During times of warfare it's important to remind yourself of where God has brought you from.

One more excellent bible verse to hold on to... is found in 2 Corinthians 5:7 (AMP) - <sup>7</sup>"For we **walk by faith** [we **regulate our lives** and conduct ourselves by our conviction or belief respecting man's relationship to God and divine things, with trust and holy fervor; thus we walk] **not by sight or appearance.**" I've highlighted part of this text to bring a special emphasis to the fact that while walking by faith, we are regulating our lives and behavior by our convictions and not by sight, or by what we see in the natural. Proclaim His strength in your weakness. Faith in God will get you through no matter what the struggle is!
