I believe the power of fasting as it relates to prayer is the spiritual atomic bomb that Jesus has given us to destroy the strongholds of evil and usher in a great revival and spiritual harvest around the world. So many people desire breakthrough.

Through fasting and prayer we humble ourselves before God so the Holy Spirit will stir our souls, awaken our churches, and heal our land according to 2 Chronicles 7:14. Make this a priority in your fasting.

Pray about the kind of fast you should undertake. Jesus implied that all of His followers should fast (Matthew 6:16-18; 9:14,15) For Him it was a matter of when believers would fast, not if they would do it.

Fasting requires reasonable precautions. Consult your physician first, especially if you take prescription medication or have a chronic ailment. Some persons should never fast without professional supervision.

Physical preparation makes the drastic change in your eating routine a little easier so that you can turn your full attention to the Lord in prayer.

- Do not rush into your fast.
- Prepare your body. Eat smaller meals before starting a fast. Avoid high-fat and sugary foods.

I recommend that you eat raw fruit and vegetables for two days before starting your fast.

My prayer for you this coming year is that you will begin 2020 strong in the Lord.



May you hear His voice loud and clearly. May you be led daily by His Word, will and ways. May you abide in His Kingdom; making healthy decisions that will cause tremendous spiritual growth and health in all areas of your life.

For maximum spiritual benefits, set aside ample time to be alone with the Lord. Expect to hear from Him. Listen for His leading. The more time you spend with Him, the more meaningful your fast will be. As you pray, do so with an expectancy and excitement that He is responding to your time with Him.

Incorporate praise and worship into your 21 days of prayer and fasting. Prophetically, see the breakthroughs that are coming your way. Give Him praise for causing victory in your life. Thank Him for all that He's doing, even for those things that you can't see in the natural.

Pray with Holy Spirit. Ask Him what He see's for your life. Pray into those things and declare what you hear Him saying to you. Expect to dream more during these upcoming 21 days. Journal your dreams. Being a yielded Jesus follower has never been so exciting!

He is responding to our corporate time of prayer and fasting. Let's believe for church growth both numerically and spiritually! As we grow we will be able to advance His Kingdom and make a greater impact in this region. I invite you to believe with me for 2020 to be a year of increase at all levels. Increase of His presence first and foremost.
