The Power Of Tenacity



It has been said that if you look at the world, you'll be distressed. If you look within, you'll be depressed. If you look at God, you'll be at rest.

2 Chronicles 15:7 NKJV says, "But you, be strong and do not let your hands be weak. For your work shall be rewarded!"

The word tenacity means to overcome obstacles and defeat unseen enemies. This is an excellent spiritual definition, that describes how the nation of Israel walked in victory.

Looking at an excellent example we find Joshua assigned to the leadership task of taking a slaved nation and turning them into victorious warrior nation. Everything that was on the other side of the Jordan was new to them. It was no longer about getting out of slavery but rather receiving through taking. The shift was: from slaves to warrior. This is a beautiful picture of our loves as Jesus followers! Check out this excellent bible verse... "Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ." Galatians 4:7 NKJV

Tenacity demands difficulty. Without difficulty there is no need for the word tenacity.

It means a worthwhile effort with doubts attached, difficulty ahead, and delay until achievement.

We need difficulty in order to become tenacious.

Tenacity stacks the small wins.

Tom Brady was once asked, "what's your secret to winning", he replied, "one play at a time."

If it's a true vision it won't happen easily or quickly. God is looking for us to exhibit tenacity.

It takes a lot of work to receive what God wants us to have, just like the work of taking the Promised Land.

Joshua gives Israel small wins along the way.

Tenacity is about the fundamentals.

There are no overnight successes—discoveries, but the work is in the fundamentals. For example, as Israel marched daily, imagine what the insiders thought! Even more so, the marchers knew they had obeyed God in the small steps.

So don't stop! Don't ever stop! Be tenacious!

There is a God who does miracles and makes walls fall down but He is not going to give it to you without doing your part. He wants to see if you are tenacious and He wants you to fight for it. In fact, He wants you to win!


