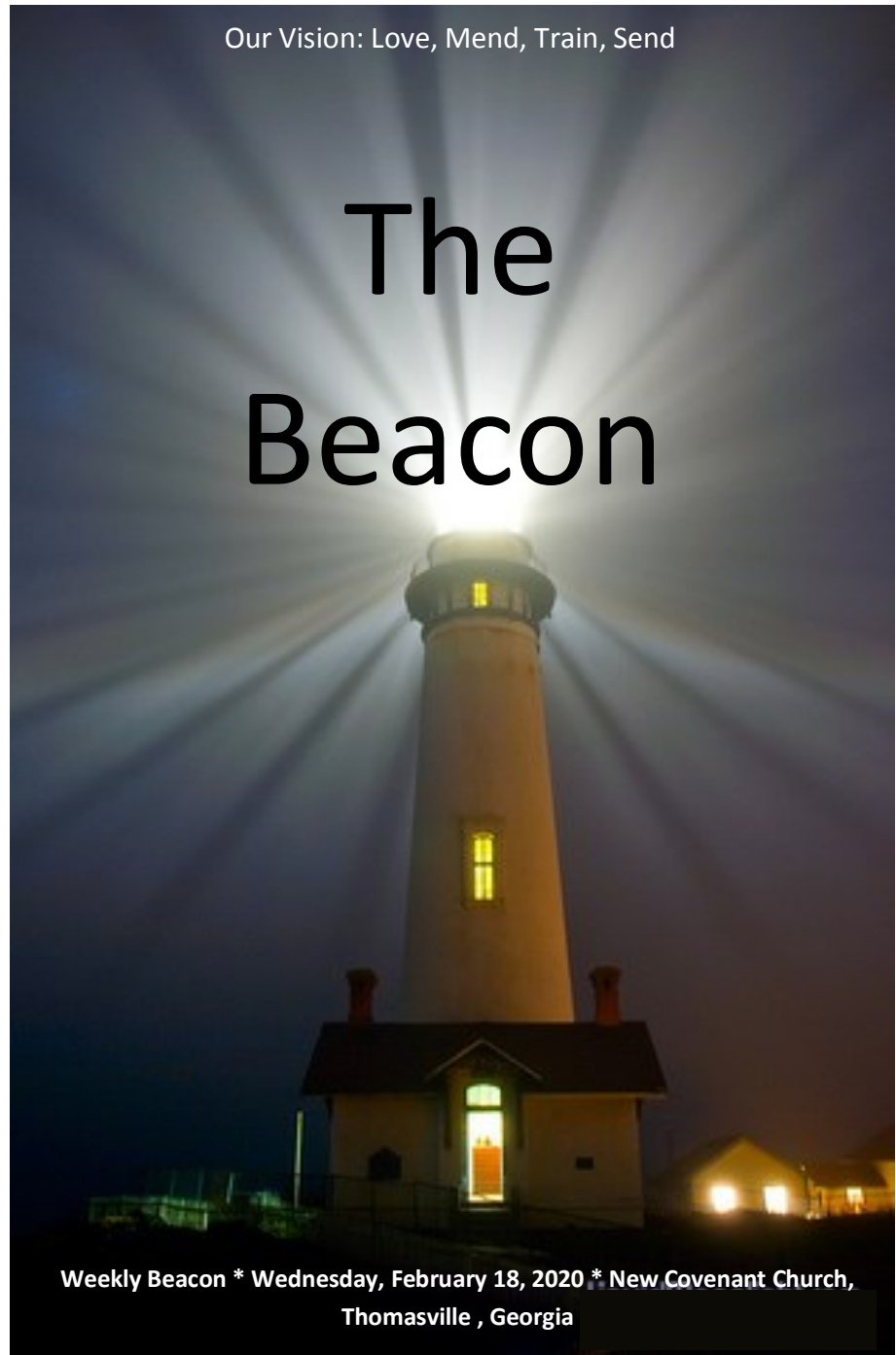

# 7 Mountains:

*Your workplace is your mission field!*



We live in a world that sees employment from a pragmatic point of view: We work to live. Hopefully we live with an ever-increasing level of material wealth, and abundance for the glory of God. For many people, work is their identity. It's common to hear people say "I'm a school teacher," or "I'm a banker." But for Christians, work has a much deeper purpose.

Dorothy Sayers, writes an essay titled, "Why Work?" Check out what she says... "Work is not, primarily, a thing one does to live, but the thing one lives to do." She adds, "It is, or it should be, the full expression of the worker's faculties, the thing in which he finds spiritual, mental and bodily satisfaction, and the medium in which he offers himself to God."

**WORK AS YOUR MISSION:** What is the church sent into the

world to do? The answer to this question is found in Jesus own words regarding the Great

Commission. Your workplace is a context in which we should want the fullness of the gospel to be lived out. There are very basic yet fundamentally important things that a godly employee must consider. 1) Living out your faith and being a good witness just by being a dependable employee affords you the opportunity to speak into people's lives. Having an excellent work ethic opens the door for co-workers and supervisors to take you seriously. Most Christians believe that every Christian has a ministry. We must be conscious of the language that we use. Keep in mind Ephesians 4:29. We leave

<sup>29</sup> Watch the way you talk. Let nothing foul or dirty come out of your mouth. Say only what helps, each word a gift.

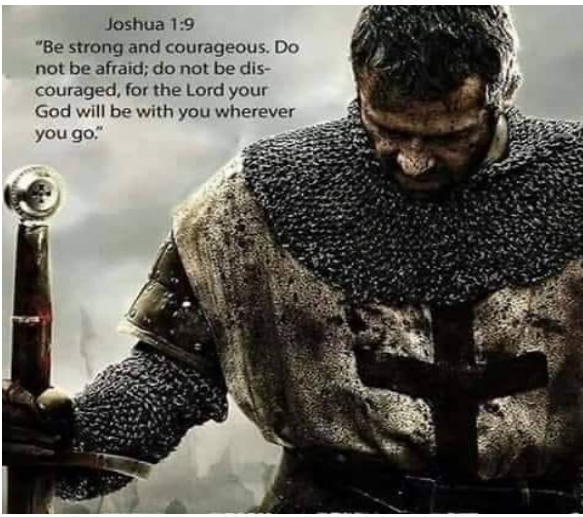
quite an impression on our co-workers and the people we work around. An excellent question to consider is,

"Where will you be on mission tomorrow at this time?" I believe it's important to reflect on what

the shape of the gospel looks like in the context of our daily life including our workplace. When we begin to understand that the gospel encompasses all of life, from the checkout line at Wal-Mart to the office, our work becomes another expression of who we are in Christ. This is vital. Seeing the 7 mountains of our culture transformed means that we are the boots on the
