




How should we respond to the recent global events surrounding the coronavirus:

1. Turn off TV! The 24 hour news cycle that reminds us every day the world is doomed. Media hype and hysteria is all based on ratings. Let's quit paying them to defeat our faith.

The airwaves in your home will disrupt your spiritual AIR-WAY!

Job 33:4, "The Spirit of God has made me; the breath of the almighty gives me life!" It is time for us to breathe again! It's interesting that this virus is a respiratory virus trying to strangle the air from people infected.

Let remember that God has got this!

It's time to wait on the goodness of the Lord! Fear corrodes our confidence in God's goodness. We must activate our faith to combat fear. Check out this next Bible verse from Psalms...

Psalms 23:6 (TPT), "So why would I fear the future? For your goodness and love pursue me all the days of my life. Then afterward, when my life is through, I'll return to your glorious presence to be forever with you!"

2. Turn worship music on in your home and speak PEACE and SAFETY over your home.

Isaiah 26:3, "You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you." Worship restores God's heart to your dwelling.

Psalms 31:19 (TPT), "Lord, how wonderful you are! You have stored up so many good things for us, like a treasure chest heaped up and spilling over with blessings— all for those who honor and worship you! Everybody knows what you can do for those who turn and hide themselves in you."

3. Declare & speak Psalm 91 over your family, friends, church, city and finances.

Pray **Psalm 91** and make this personal each day until we get the all clear on the virus from the authorities. Verses 1-7 are powerful: "1 He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. 2 I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust." 3 Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the perilous pestilence.

4 He shall cover you with His feathers, and under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth shall be your shield and buckler.

5 You shall not be afraid of the terror by night, nor of the arrow that flies by day,

6 Nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday.

7 A thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right hand;

But it shall not come near you. 8 Only with your eyes shall you look, and see the reward of the wicked. 9

Because you have made the Lord, who is my refuge..."

Lastly, **Use your God given authority!** Pray the prayer with authority that Apostle Paul prayed in **Ephesians 1:18-23**.

Declaring, praying, and activating your faith during these times will do more to encourage you and position yourself to be a blessing to people around you in need. Let's stay prayed up and ready to help when the time comes!
