

In today's article, I've selected the perfect Bible verse to the church in Philippi (Philippians 3:14-21 MGS).

14 "By no means do I count myself an expert in all of this, but I've got my eye on the goal, where God is beckoning us onward—to Jesus. I'm off and running, and I'm not turning back.

15-16 So let's keep focused on that goal, those of us who want everything God has for us. If any of you have something else in mind, something less than total commitment, God will clear your blurred vision—you'll see it yet! Now that we're on the right track, let's stay on it.

17-19 Stick with me, friends. Keep track of those you see running this same course, headed for this same goal. There are many out there taking other paths, choosing other goals, and trying to get you to go along with them. I've warned you of them many times; sadly, I'm having to do it again. All they want is easy street. They hate Christ's Cross. But easy street is a dead-end street. Those who live there make their bellies their gods; belches are their praise; all they can think of is their appetites. 20-21 But there's far more to life for us. We're citizens of high heaven! We're waiting the arrival of the Savior, the Master, Jesus Christ, who will transform our earthy bodies into glorious bodies like his own. He'll make us beautiful and whole with the

putting everything as it should be, under and around him."


As we consider verse 14, the question for us today is, what are you looking at? Are your eyes still on the goal? Before COVID-19 arrived in our area, we were rocking right along doing our own thing for the Kingdom. Then all of a sudden, there was a rush on toilet paper, then cleaning supplies that contained bleach, wipes of almost every kind, and then paper toweling and sure enough even Kleenex became scarce at the stores. What happened? I think people's focus changed in an instant. Shoppers heard news somewhere that it was time to stock up. And so they did. To this day, toilet paper can't be found unless you are at the store when the doors open early in the morning. My focus is on the Kingdom of God! Truthfully, that's where it's been all along. We never hoarded supplies.

It's interesting how much of our lives have changed since the outbreak of the corona virus. Alli and I are enjoying inviting people from all over the country into our home to share Communion, pray, and study the Bible through the simple medium of Live-Stream. Verse 17 speaks of relationship. We must keep track of those that we see running the same course we're on. I hope you're connected with your NCC family members. As followers of Jesus, there's no easy street. We are citizens of high heaven. Let's continue to behave as such.
