Two Keys to Revival!



In case you missed it, Sunday, I preached on the subject of revival. Back in the day, the Methodist denomination was full of Holy Spirit power that had a tremendous global impact for the Kingdom of God.

John Wesley once said, "My fear is not that our great movement known as the Methodists will eventually cease to exist or one day die from the earth. My fear is that our people will become content to love without the fire, the power, the excitement, the supernatural element that makes us great."

John Wesley had a deep desire for the Methodists to maintain their passion for the Lord as well as their effectiveness for eternity's sake on the earth. Tragically, as with many church institutions, John Wesley's fears have come true within a large portion of the movement that he birthed. The once vibrant and powerful Methodist Church has now even come to a place where they are debating whether or not to ordain homosexuals into the ministry. The fact is John Wesley most likely never even imagined this level of backsliding; however, this is where his movement finds itself today. My point isn't to pick on a particular denomination but to simply point out that what has happened to this once powerful church is happening in many others all over our country. Churches are more focused on being seeker friendly and man pleasing instead of being the presence [of God] focused.

Through spiritual hunger and humility in prayer, we can expect a mighty move of Holy Spirit to take place right here at NCC. The purpose of this move isn't to become a spiritual attraction but to see God transform, change, and heal our city, region and state with the Good News and power of God.

Jesus says to us in **Acts 1:8** AMP "But you will receive power and ability when the Holy Spirit comes upon you; and you will be My witnesses [to tell people about Me] both in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and Samaria, and even to the ends of the earth." Receive the power that flows through you but remember God determines its purpose. Revival humility submits to God's will even if it wrecks all selfish ambition.
