

## From The Desk of Pastor Dave



This last Saturday was a day of national prayers, prayer marches, and repentance for the sin in America. Everything about it was excellent! I appreciate all of you who participated at home, on the road while using your mobile devices to activate your faith and come into alignment with the leaders of these important events. You can watch Rabbi Jonathan's message if you did not see it live on Youtube. Let's continue to pray that this time will bear strong, positive fruit and the turnaround that God desires to do.

Sunday, we will be celebrating Feast of Tabernacles! This will be a time to remember our Lord's goodness and faithfulness to the Jewish people as they wandered in the desert while meeting with God. The significance for us is that Jesus (Yeshua) desires us to be in relationship with Him moment by moment. He's given His Spirit and placed it inside of us so that we can be in constant fellowship with Him. I'm looking forward to all of us being together to bring praise and worship while "remembering" not only the story of Tabernacles but the biblical implications for us today. There are so many promises that are connected to Sukkot (Tabernacles). It is no coincidence that Jesus chose this occasion of Hoshana Rabbah, which is the last and greatest day of Sukkot to make the declaration that "If a man is thirsty let him come to me to drink" (John 7:38). Yeshua proclaimed himself to be the Great Provider, the Redeemer of Israel who led the people through the wilderness. He is the great light shining in the darkness, and his body is the great Temple which was raised up after being destroyed as the final sin offering. He provided the final and greatest atonement for his people Israel and for all nations. Psalm 118, (part of the great "Hallel") is chanted during this feast. It says... "the stone the builders rejected has become the capstone" (verse 22). As the bright light shone from despised Galilee, so the rejected Messiah became the capstone of a new temple.

Messiah promised "living water" for all who believe. What is living water? It is cool, fresh spring water. In the land of Israel water is especially precious. Jesus promised, the best water, real spiritual satisfaction. This is the Shekinah promise to those who believe. It's interesting that most people have not tasted this living water. Like some of the Pharisees and priests of Jesus' day, people are still wise in their own eyes. But the truly wise can learn a lesson from the wilderness wandering of ancient Israel. Of all those 20 or more years old who came out of Egypt only two entered the Promised Land, Joshua and Caleb. God is the source of truth and he does promise to reveal himself to those of us who truly want to know. Consider the words of the great prophet Jeremiah... "You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart" (Jeremiah 29:13).

# Feast Of TABERNACLES

Leviticus 23:33-36 (NKJV)

<sup>33</sup> Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, <sup>34</sup> "Speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'The fifteenth day of this seventh month shall be the Feast of Tabernacles for seven days to the LORD. <sup>35</sup> On the first day there shall be a holy convocation. You shall do no customary work on it. <sup>36</sup> For seven days you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. On the eighth day you shall have a holy convocation, and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. It is a sacred assembly, and you shall do no customary work on it.'
