We know that the way the enemy dealt with Adam and Eve was the slippery slope of deception. Satan had to start the conversation with "has God not said?" This reveals to us that one of the strategies of the enemy is to get us to question what God says. A second strategy of the enemy is to get people to question their identity. Consider when Jesus was tempted in the wilderness... the devil came to Him to and said, "if you're the Son of God" -calling into question his divine identity. Of course Jesus didn't fall for the enemy's schemes. What was the strategy that Jesus used? He fought the enemy with scripture ... "It is written". We must be aware that the enemy will try to weaken us in these two things, so that we will become vulnerable to the plans of the enemy who comes to steal, kill and destroy (John 10:10). So what is the solution? Apostle Paul says to be armored up in **Ephesians 6:10-18**.

We must be careful not to draw strength outside of Christ. We can position ourselves as an open target to the enemy if we aren't careful. Our flesh will fail us. This world will offer us so much, but in the end it all fades away. This time of year Halloween parties and the celebration of this holiday seems harmless and simple enough for a little fun. A little known fact is that there's something far more sinister going on than we may be aware of. Witches, warlocks and neo-pagans spend this month praying and fasting and sending forth curses into the lives of Christians, against churches and ministries. Again, we must not be ignorant of the enemy's devices and plans against Christians. There's two reasons for this... The first is because during Halloween, curses are being sent forth by the demonic realm that is operating against us. The second is because with Thanksgiving and Christmas approaching, the enemy wants to wreak havoc on us and all the joy we have of celebrating the birth of our Savior and being thankful for everything God has given us around Thanksgiving. So, we are in a season of intense spiritual warfare. What can we do? **Stay connected.** This is a time to remain connected to God and connected to each other. We need each other and we certainly need God. Take authority over your spiritual environment, including your marriage and family. I also want to encourage you to pray and fast. Let's come together Saturday to pray and seek God for ourselves and nation.
