



From the Desk of Pastor Dave: Who's Report Do You Believe?



Every day we get "reports" from news media. It's sad that the current state of affairs regarding news and information can no longer be trusted and relied upon. Network news corporations understand that fear sells. Ironically, we are the most prosperous generation living in the most prosperous nation in history, and the most fearful one too. In the past you had to wait til the evening news came on to get their daily dose of anxiety; today it is accessed around the clock on the web, iPhones or iPads, etc. We receive other kinds of reports. Reports that come from doctors, our experiences, our friends and family, just to name a few. If you're not selective in who you listen to, you can lose your peace of mind. This is exactly what the enemy wants to accomplish. Stealing your peace and hope is a strategy of the enemy.

The good news is that God knows this, so His Word asks, "Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed -(Isaiah 53:1 NKJV)?" The bottom line is that there is man's report and then there's the Lord's report.

In Scripture, the "arm of the Lord" speaks of His power to deliver and His providential care over every event in our lives. So, whose report are you listening to? When we listen to any kind of a report it is internalized once it goes through our ear gates and then there is a response that will follow. How will you respond when you receive news that doesn't line up with the will of the Lord for your life?

Have you ever noticed that when we receive a report from the Word of God, it oftentimes contradicts what everyone else is saying? When this happens, we have a choice to make. Do you believe what you hear in the natural, or do you believe the report of the Lord?

Just because you don't see a solution doesn't mean that God doesn't have one. He can bring one opportunity across your path that will thrust you to new levels of provision and breakthrough.

He has explosive blessings that can blast you out of debt and into a place of abundance. What is required of us? Obedience. Obedience to His Holy Word. Because there's always something that's required of us in order for God to be able to manifest His will in our lives. There's a scriptural formula for us to consider...

We must **surrender** which allows us to **obey**. **Faith**; produces expectancy. **God's Word**; provides us with needed resources to stand on. We call these, His promises. His **leading**; through Holy Spirit, is so important. The last key in this formula is to declare and speak what God's Word says.

Allow me to remind you that what you're facing today may be considered an impossible situation, but, with God, all things are possible! Life is filled with choices. Each choice brings a reward or a consequence.

Have you ever met someone who had something really bad happen to them and they accepted the outcome without even putting up a fight?

There's a few reasons why someone would do this.... Ignorance; a lack of teaching and understanding from God's Word. This includes a lack of understanding of who they are in Christ. The result is that they fail to see themselves the way that God see's themself.

There's a report from the Lord for you. What does His report say about your circumstances? Make a choice. Choose today to believe the report of the Lord. He has your back and has a plan to see you succeed. Apostle Paul says **Philippians 1:6 AMP** ¹ I am convinced and confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will [continue to] perfect and complete it until the day of Christ Jesus [the time of His return]. God has a plan for you, our community, state and America. Let's look forward to seeing the goodness and the glory of the Lord manifest in the world. We can stand in faith that He will fulfill His plan and expose and overturn the enemy's works. Together, we will believe the report of the Lord and look forward to inheriting His wonderful blessings and promises both in this world and in the world to come. Give God thanks as He provides the turn around you're believing for! The best is yet to come.
