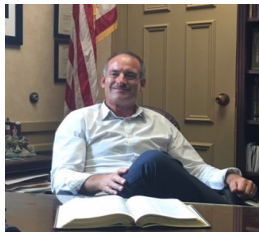

## From the Desk of Pastor Dave: -Liberty!



Sunday was Freedom Sunday! As we celebrated America's 245th birthday, we considered the word "liberty" The Apostle Paul tells the Church in Galatia that they must stand fast.

**Galatians 5:1 NKJV** *Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage.*

Let me remind you that we are members of the Army of the Lord! As soldiers in His Army we must stand fast. Stand fast in the liberty by which Christ has made us free. *Let's walk in liberty!* Do you consider yourself a yielded follower of Jesus Christ? **1 John 1:9 TPT** <sup>9</sup> *But if we freely admit our sins when his light uncovers them, he will be faithful to forgive us every time. God is just to forgive us our sins because of Christ, and he will continue to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.*

It's wonderful to know you've been set free from the law of sin and death. It's also glorious to know you never again have to submit to the slavery of sin. But what do you do when, in spite of those wonderful truths, you miss the mark? What should you do if you stumble and sin? Our response should be to run to our Father, confess, and repent! That sounds simple. But oddly enough, people oftentimes do the opposite. Instead of running to God, people let fear and guilt overwhelm them. Some, start thinking things like, "well, I've missed it now. I might as well forget the rest of it and keep sinning." That attitude and mindset is not part of the law of liberty that Christ has given us.

Be careful not to let Satan talk you into compromising with sin in one area of your life just because you missed it in another. When you get off track with God, confess it and get right back on the track of obedience.

Receive His forgiveness. Receive His cleansing. No matter how badly you've sinned, Father God is eager to forgive and to cleanse us of all unrighteousness! We have been liberated through Jesus Christ. There's two forces within us are constantly fighting...to win control over us, and our desires are never free from their pressures. But when Holy Spirit controls our lives he produces this kind of fruit in us: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control". You ask, "Is such a lifestyle even possible?" Yes, but you must make these four things(1) Remember that Satan never takes a day off. Neither does Holy Spirit! Protect yourself with God's Word and prayer. Declare what God says about you. (2) Identify the sin you're most prone to. The Bible says, "Lay aside...the sin which so easily ensnares" (Hebrews 12:1 NKJV). Why? Because the area of your greatest weakness is the one in which you'll constantly be attacked. Holy Spirit wants you to overcome, to walk in Liberty!
