


## From the Desk of Pastor Dave

Being Transformed  
Psalm 19:14

Sunday we looked at King David's writings in Psalm 19:14. Let's take a look at what he says ... **Psalm 19:14 AMP** <sup>14</sup> *"Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable and pleasing in Your sight, O Lord, my [firm, immovable] rock and my Redeemer."*

**C. S. Lewis** once said regarding Psalm 19... "I take this Psalm to be the greatest poem in the Psalms and one of the greatest lyrics in the world."

The emphasis in the psalm is on God's revelations of Himself in creation, Scripture, and the human heart. David closes this Psalm with verse 14 revealing the humility that was in his heart and his desire to be a delight to the Lord. David was the man after God's own heart for he realized that it is not only the outside of a cup that needs to be clean, but God desires an inner purity, which stems from a heart that is humble before the Lord and from



whom will stream rivers of living water. A heart that meditates on the Lord and lifts up Jesus, is the one that exhibits an inner grace and peace, for such a person is willingly being transformed into the likeness of the Christ, for out of the mouth come thoughts that are conceived in the heart. David not only understood the need for an inner cleansing and purity on a daily basis; where God Himself governs and sanctifies his thoughts of the heart and the words of his mouth. We must also come to an understanding that the Lord Jesus is the strength of our life and the only kinsman redeemer for our soul. When we know Jesus our Lord as a Rock (Protector) and our Redeemer, then we are able to fulfill His will for our lives.

As obedient followers of Jesus Christ, we are blessed with this supernatural flow in our lives. I invite you to step into the river of God. Let's wade in further. Let's swim deep in the river of God! Jesus was led by the Spirit to say and do what the Father was doing. He was grounded in the Word

of God and He was sensitive to the flow of the anointing coming upon Him and through Him. The anointing is God's power released to accomplish His supernatural purposes. It can manifest like a feeling, a sensing, a surge of authority or a presence of calm and peace that comes upon you. If you haven't already learned how to flow with the Spirit, you should take time to do so in your everyday life. We all need Holy Spirit. All of us need His anointing to flow with His plan. How does someone learn to flow? Starts with being baptized in the Holy Spirit. Then, spend what I call quality time with God. - In His presence. While there, pray and quiet yourself and listen for His voice. Follow His lead. When Holy Spirit is directing you to reach out to someone, you may sense His guidance in various ways. There are a variety of ways in which Holy Spirit will get our attention. The key is to be sure that we are sensitive to His leading. May you be blessed as you draw near to Him.
