





From the Desk of Pastor Dave

PRAY
FOR THE PEACE OF
JERUSALEM

Sunday, we looked at **2 Corinthians 2:14-17 (TPT)** and broke down the following scripture from Apostle Paul. He says the following... ¹⁴ "God always makes his grace visible in Christ, who includes us as partners of his endless triumph. Through our yielded lives he spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of God everywhere we go. ¹⁵ We have become the unmistakable aroma of the victory of the Anointed One to God—a perfume of life to those being saved and the odor of death to those who are perishing. ¹⁶ The unbelievers smell a deadly stench that leads to death, but believers smell the life-giving aroma that leads to abundant life. And who of us can rise to this challenge? ¹⁷ For unlike so many, we are not peddlers of God's Word who water down the message. We are those sent from God with pure motives, who speak in the sight of God from our union with Christ."

In verse 14 we read that God reveals his amazing grace to those of us who are in Christ. This verse contains a promise that God **always makes his grace visible**. Staying yielded is the key to our awareness of Holy Spirit's presence. As overcomers, this is so important. In the following verse we are told that we carry an aroma, a fragrance of the knowledge of God. Talk about a blessing!

Believe it or not, people are aware of Christ in us and his victory in us. The world needs to experience this aroma of victory that we carry because of what Holy Spirit has done. Each of us has a story that contains testimonies of God's miraculous power at work in lives. Now more than ever we must share this

amazing work. With all of the negativity in the world today, we can spread good news and the Good News. Apostle Paul tells us in verse 17 that we are not peddlers who water down the message. On the contrary, you and I are sent! Sent by God with a purpose. Let's use that purpose to bless others. As overcomers we can learn a lot from Biblical leaders like Joshua. You'll recall how he heard from the Lord and was given specific battle plan instructions as to how he and his army were to take the city of Jericho. Because they followed God's instructions, the walls came down. We must remain yielded in Christ. This allows us to be led by Holy Spirit and receive the victory against obstacles that the enemy places in front of us. What are the finer points worth remembering? Check out the following ...

Joshua heard God speaking and listened to him. Joshua followed God, no matter what journey or battle looked like. **Joshua waited on the Lord. Joshua needed God in order to see the victory come to pass. Joshua found out that what God promises he will fulfill! Joshua also discovered that God is a God of the miraculous and, that God will do it again.** So, let's rise up. We are overcomers who've been so blessed. Let's learn from Joshua and follow his example of trusting God, being obedient, and waiting on him to come through with our victory! Victory is on the way!
