

From the desk of Pastor Dave: “Immanuel”



Isaiah 7:14 AMPC—Therefore the Lord Himself shall give you a sign: Behold, the young woman who is unmarried and a virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel [God with us].

God created the heavens and the earth and everything in them. He created man and woman and gave mankind dominion and authority,

He instructed us to rule over and to manage the earth and everything on the earth. Everything on earth belonged to You God, because He owned everything, He could with it as He wished.

He chose to give humanity authority and dominion over all the earth.

Genesis 1:26-28 NKJV—Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our Image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the flesh of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth. So God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him, male and female He created them. 28 Then god blessed them, and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on earth.

God gives us purpose. Do you know why you're here, why He created you? What's your purpose? Verse 28 is the key... “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.”

Myles Munroe once said, “The greatest tragedy in life is not death, but a life without a purpose”. Jesus understood his purpose. His destiny was to live so He could die so that we would live.

Is your purpose wrapped around the destiny that God has placed in you?

Through Adam, man gave the dominion and authority that God had given him to rule over the earth to Satan. It was disobedience that separated human beings from God. What man lost through disobedience was his relationship with God, and we must remember that all dominion and authority are relational.

God is the God of relationship; He created humanity for that purpose. Relationship requires fellowship. Fellowship requires time spent together. Time spent together requires the commitment to invest in that relationship. There are no shortcuts!

If we aren't in relationship with God, then we don't have any authority or dominion. Your purpose can't be fulfilled outside of the Kingdom of God. God Himself came to the earth in the person of Jesus Christ, Emmanuel-God with us. Jesus, engaged and defeated Satan and took back the dominion and the authority that man had given to Satan. Having defeated Satan, He gives us access to that power. Thank the Lord for His Holy Spirit.

While Jesus was on earth, He established and delivered the System—the Kingdom system whereby we can live on the earth in complete victory, in a living, breathing, flowing relationship with our Living God. Emmanuel - God with us!

The Kingdom is your complete and your total order for everything. All governments and authorities have requirements that must be obeyed. We must be in right relationship with the ruling authority of God's government in order to receive the benefits offered by His government. These benefits include the abundant life.

Immanuel, God with us. Let's keep in the center of this Christmas season.
