



# From the Desk of Pastor Dave

#### Developing a lifestyle of Thankfulness



Sunday was such a fun day for Alli and I. We were so excited to honor our servants who do so many things behind the scenes here at NCC. It was a pleasure to recognize so many of you! Now more than ever, I believe it's important to give honor where it is due. Without you, the ministry of New Covenant Church wouldn't be strong and healthy. So, thank you for your faithfulness, and consistently serving with a spirit of excellence and a smile. It goes a long way and means so much.

If you missed being here Sunday and wonder why we didn't announce it or give anyone a heads up about this special service, it's because we wanted this event to be a surprise. I like good surprises and I wanted the element of surprise to be part of what made Sunday special for those who were there.

The Apostle Paul speaks about the importance of unity in the midst of diversity within the body. In 1 Corinthians 12:12-27 he says the following <sup>12</sup> For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ. 13 For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and have all been made to drink into one Spirit. <sup>14</sup> For in fact the body is not one member but many. <sup>15</sup> If the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I am not of the body," is it therefore not of the body? 16 And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I am not of the body," is it therefore not of the body?  $^{17}$  If the whole body were an eye, where would be the hearing? If the whole were hearing, where would be the smelling? <sup>18</sup> But now God has set the members, each one of them, in the body just as He pleased. <sup>19</sup> And if they were all one

member, where would the body be?

<sup>20</sup>But now indeed there are many members, yet one body. <sup>21</sup> And the eye cannot say to the hand, "I have no need of you"; nor again the head to the feet, "I have no need of you." <sup>22</sup> No, much rather, those members of the body which seem to be weaker necessary. 23 And those members of the body which we think to be less honorable, on these we honor: and bestow greater unpresentable parts have greater modesty,<sup>24</sup>but our presentable parts have no need. But God composed the body, having given greater honor to that part which lacks it, <sup>25</sup> that there should be no schism in the body, but that the members should have the same care for another. 26 And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; or if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it. <sup>27</sup> Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually. Let's remember that we are one body of believers and as such, we are family. It is a great privilege for Alli and I to be your pastors. We love each of you and are thankful for all of our NCC family. We know that our best years are in front of us and are excited about the year ahead. During this Thanksgiving season I hope reality of Holy Spirit's presence is surrounding you. Be sure to pick up your copy in the lobby of 30 Days of Gratitude Exploring The Attributes Of God. This is a great Biblical resource to remain grateful to God for all He's done!
