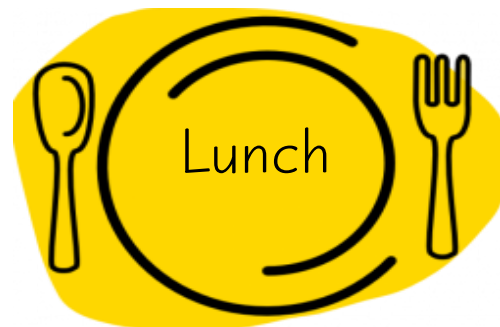

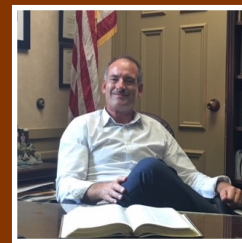

Let's Make A Declaration!

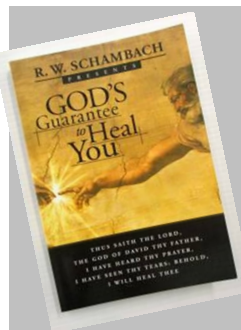


During these 21 days of praying and fasting a key element to incorporate into our time with the Lord is to take His Word; the Bible, and declare it over our prayer requests. When we press in by taking hold of God's promises, what we're doing, is pulling Heaven down to earth. It's a powerful thing to take the power of God's Word and speak it. The definition of the word declare is to make known. When we make decrees, we're commanding with authority. The Bible tells us that we've been given governmental authority through Jesus Christ (Luke 10:19). Jesus also says in Matthew 16:19 "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." It's important that we assert what Jesus says and apply these truths to our lives as members of the Body of Christ. During these 21 days, let's continue to move in close to our Heavenly Father and catch His vision for our lives and the situations that we're in. When we see what He sees we are able to decree prophetically and say what He says. A true prophetic declaration is scripturally based and can be drawn upon for a specific time or event. In the Old Testament, we can draw from some great examples in the lives of Esther, Ezra and Daniel. The key to breakthrough comes through exercising our faith in God's Word and speaking it out loud. What we're doing is coming into agreement with the voice of God. Change will

come. We know that God speaks to us in many different ways. He uses our dreams, visions, angelic visitations, other people and that still small voice inside of us. Some people have heard God's audible voice. I look forward to the day I can say that I am one of them. No matter, we have His holy Word to hear him loud and clear. I believe that this year, 2022 will be a year of breakthrough, divine reversals, and great turnarounds for us, our community and America. God wants to use His Church to bring about a great awakening that will advance His Kingdom. It's about nations serving Him.

During Sunday's message, we looked at Joshua and how God used him to lead the Israelites to go in and take the promised land. Feel free to read Joshua chapter 1. God gives him both a promise and the instructions to fulfill that promise.

Part of our 21 days of praying and fasting should include Bible reading and meditation. The Hebrew word for meditate is *Hagah*. This word is an active word which means to growl, moan, to utter davening. Davening is something the Jews do at the Western Wall in Jerusalem. It's common to see the men and boys rocking back and forth while they are praying. Hagah, moves the heart of God with our prayers. With Biblical meditation, there's an expectation that rises up within us that accompanies feelings of excitement about what God is about to do. James reminds us that our faith must be backed up with action. "For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without words is dead also" (James 2:26). What do you want to see this year? Take a Bible verse stand on it, and declare it. Then, watch God move on your behalf! God bless you as you continue to fast and pray! The best is yet to come!
