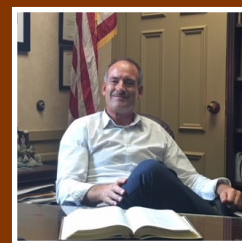

Let's Endure to the End!



We are living during a time when more than ever, people are looking for some kind of peace in their lives. **Job 22:21 AMPC** ²¹ *“Acquaint now yourself with Him [agree with God and show yourself to be conformed to His will] and be at peace; by that [you shall prosper and great] good shall come to you.”*

I believe that this Bible verse holds the key for you to begin to experience the rewards and blessings of living in the Kingdom of God. Job says that we are to be acquainted with God and come into agreement with Him. For us to be able to do this, we must subject our flesh and our soul to the will of God through the work of Holy Spirit. When we are conformed to His will, Job says that we will experience peace. Two characteristics of the Hebrew word Shalom (peace) is abundance and prosperity. I'm looking for all kinds of good things to take place and happen this year. Purpose in your heart that no matter the challenge, you will grab ahold of Shalom and experience His presence, as He carries you through to victory.

James tells us (**James 1:2-3 TPT**) *“My fellow believers, when it seems as though you are facing nothing but difficulties, see it as an invaluable opportunity to experience the greatest joy that you can! For you know that when your faith is tested it stirs up in you the power of endurance.”* Endurance is a common lacking ingredient in many Christians lives today. Because we live in a “quick fix” culture where we don't have to wait for much, we want God to produce the results without having to endure with patience and trust in His timing. Being joyful when our flesh rises up in opposition requires a purpose driven attitude that says “I choose to live in joy today even if I don't like what's happening right now.” We need to remember that there is an enemy out there and his name is Satan. His job is to deceive, and divide. He will take any ground given to him and run with it to accomplish his diabolical plan. Praise God we have the triune God! Father, Son and Holy Spirit at our disposal coupled with His holy Word. I challenge you that as you finish this season of praying and fasting to do so with great purpose and the endurance of an Olympic athlete. God's grace is there at your disposal to get you through to the finish line! He is faithful to do it. Consider the words of Apostle Paul in **1 Corinthians 10:13 TPT** ... *“We all experience times of testing, which is normal for every human being. But God will be faithful to you. He will screen and filter the severity, nature, and timing of every test or trial you face so that you can bear it. And each test is an opportunity to trust him more, for along with every trial God has provided for you a way of escape that will bring you out of it victoriously.”* What a great promise! Begin to see your problems as opportunities for God to lead you into victory!
