From the Desk of Pastor Dave

"For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope. —Jeremiah 29:11 NKJV



This Bible verse from the Prophet Jeremiah reminds us from His own Word, the Bible, what an Immense care God has for each one of us, individually. He cares for us, has a plan for us, He will not forsake us, and wants us to spend eternity with Him! And, until that day, there's much He wants us to do for His Kingdom.

Self-worth is heightened dramatically by someone that you respect, someone of importance, in authority that shows value to you. They value you. What they think about you can cause your self worth to rise.

Potential that is inside of you can explode with passionate energy. What someone says to you, can pull on the potential that's in you or it can do the opposite, and quench potential in you. This is why it's so important to cast it away when the words don't line up with God's Word.

Someone of importance or in authority can speak into your life and it can quench your potential if they're the wrong words; words that are abusive. We know that abuse includes verbal, emotional and physical. Verbal abuse could just be a word that cancels or stifles the potential that's inside of you.
