From the Desk of Pastor Dave



“And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.”

How many times have you read, heard, sung, or prayed the Lord's Prayer? Have you felt as if the Lord's Prayer doesn't go beyond the ceiling? You pray, but there is no deliverable received or manifestation seen. The Lord's Prayer is all about relationship and your entrance into the Courts of Heaven.

When you position yourself in your true, God-given identity, Father God invites you into His courts so that He may...

- Reveal His glory to you
- Pour out His glory upon you, as a son or daughter
- Allow you to claim your “bread” of provision
- Give you an anointing and assignment
- Fight your battles for you

The journey of the Lord's Prayer starts in the room of atonement. When you pray, take time to meditate and allow your spirit and your mind to go into the Lord's place of cleansing. James 5:16 says, *“Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.”* Prayer avails when you go into the room of atonement first. By doing this, the accuser no longer has a legal right to cancel your prayers. We must surrender those things to the Lord. Then we can confess any

impure motives that were behind any actions or statements we did, said, or thought. When we do this, we experience freedom. This is ultimately what Jesus died on the cross for! Our freedom. Forgiveness is a spiritual force and activator in the Courts of Heaven. Tragically, some people have gotten comfortable with holding on to unforgiveness. **If there is unforgiveness in your heart, the enemy has a legal right to prevent the release of God's Word as a manifestation in your life.** Apostle Paul says... **Ephesians 4:25-28 NKJV**

*“Therefore, putting away lying, “Let each one of you speak truth with his neighbor,” for we are members of one another. 26 “Be angry, and do not sin”: do not let the sun go down on your wrath, 27 **nor give place to the devil.** 28 Let him who stole steal no longer, but rather let him labor, working with his hands what is good, that he may have something to give him who has need.”* If you're struggling with forgiving someone, get yourself a copy of the book Total Forgiveness by R.T. Kendall. Lean on Holy Spirit and stand on God's Word to see you through!
