


Items needed include:

From the Desk of Pastor Dave

Let's be a light for Jesus!

Philippians 2:14-15



Apostle Paul tells the church in Philippi the following... ¹⁴ *Do all things without complaining and disputing,* ¹⁵ *that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world*" (Philippians 2:14-15). All of us have a testimony. Each of us can give God praise for great things that he has done in our lifetime. There's no doubt that as this world gets spiritually darker in these last days, God wants the light of his Son, Jesus, to shine bright in our lives. What does it mean to "shine bright"? I believe that if we allow two key ingredients to be at work in our lives, we will see the impact of Holy Spirit flow through us and we will be a blessing to others around us. These two key components to our Christian life is the Bible, and Holy Spirit.

Sundays sermon was about why the Bible is important and how reading it daily allows us to grow spiritually. There are many great devotionals available. As great as all of these are, nothing must take the place of reading the Bible. A true revelation of God's Word is the single most important element of a victorious Christian life. Think back to when you read your Bible, and a verse jumped out at you and you knew it was God speaking to you. How did this impact you? Was it a verse of correction? Possibly confirmation? Perhaps it was a word of revelation where truth was being imparted into you as you read each verse. The Bible is spiritual food that we must receive daily. The writer of the book of Hebrews talks about the amazing elements of God's holy word. It brings conviction, deliverance, salvation, healing, affecting our soul and our spirit. Let's

take a look at what is written in **Hebrews 4:12 AMPC** ... ¹² *For the Word that God speaks is alive and full of power [making it active, operative, energizing, and effective]; it is sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating to the dividing line of the breath of life (soul) and [the immortal] spirit, and of joints and marrow [of the deepest parts of our nature], exposing and sifting and analyzing and judging the very thoughts and purposes of the heart.*

God desires us to be successful! It begins with our salvation experience and then spiritual growth. He wants us to advance his Kingdom while there's still time. Sharing our testimony with others; all the exciting things Holy Spirit does in our everyday lives. Let's not let fear and other hindrances keep us from being a light to those who need encouragement. In this dark world it's far greater to light a candle than to curse the darkness. May you be the light for Jesus as his Holy Spirit guides you to shine!
