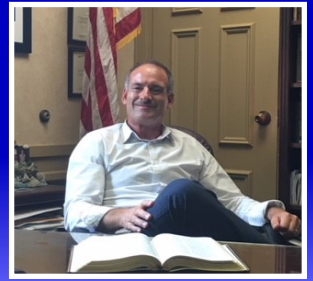

# From the Desk of Pastor Dave

*Sermon from Vince Curtis, July 24th*

*"Laying the Foundation"*



The Book of Nehemiah is one of the greatest administrative books ever compiled by God in the Bible. The scriptures are so instructive, they contain so many tools that we need in life. Nehemiah was able to take 40,000 men to do a task under his governing rule. It is a task that in today's world would be nearly impossible to get everyone on the same page. You are going to have opposition.

Nehemiah was a praying man. We should live by his example and do this daily. Prayer must be the foundation. We cannot do anything without a key foundation.

The Psalmist says... "Commit your way to the LORD, Trust also in Him, And He shall bring it to pass."

The church is us and it takes more than 1 to make a church grow. The first thing that was built in Jerusalem was the Temple. If we get the foundation right then the rest of the stones fall into place. If we get the prayer right, if we get our heart right, then the construction goes easier. It's called work. In our church world, in our individual lives, we have forgotten that we need to work. We have forgotten that it actually takes something to get something.

In our community, New Covenant, we need to reach outside the walls of this church, because with that, our church will be strengthened. We are all in the same boat. We are still rowing against the same current. But the enemy is against all of us and wants us to be against each other.

We all represent one brick. One brick at the top builds a church. With the foundation right, the other stones will line up perfectly with the center stone. The most and longest part of building anything is the foundation. When you get the foundation right, the other stones will line up perfectly with the center stone. When you are building something it always matters what you are building it to. The most important job of building anything is prep work. Jesus is the mortar that binds the bricks that represents us. But without the bricks, there is nothing to build.

It is important that people show up for church because we are all one of the bricks. The enemy says I don't want all the bricks to get together, so I'm going to take one of the bricks and tell it to stay home. It's all about us being connected together. One brick has no function by itself. Once you get all the bricks together it is a fortitude.

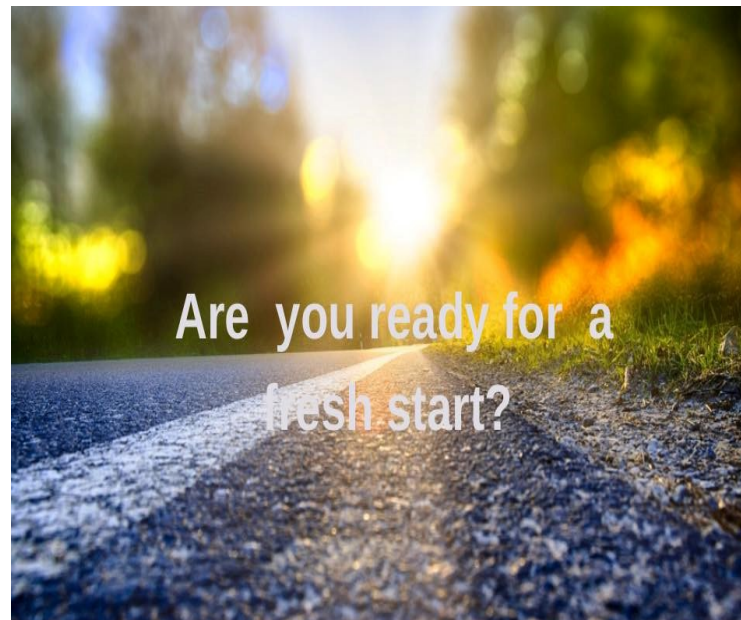
We should all look out for each other. We are our Brother's keeper.
