



From the Desk of Pastor Dave Let's Celebrate Life



I recently stated on my Facebook page that I am humbled to pastor a pro-life church. In this day and age where right has now been considered wrong, and wrong right, we must take a bold stand for truth and righteousness. The Bible must continue to be our standard and we must resist the urge to cherry pick our way through the Scriptures, only agreeing with the passages that we're comfortable with.

There's compromise in the Body of Christ, and sadly, it appears that the divide in the Church in America is only getting deeper and wider between Christians that are sold out to Jesus Christ and the Word of God and those who are not. Abortion has been a polarizing issue since the Supreme Court first ruled in Roe vs. Wade back in 1973.

Why should this issue matter to us? 1) The Bible makes it clear that God is the giver of life.
