I am excited to share with you some great things that are happening at NCC! **Fresh Start Recovery Ministry** is going very well. We have a core group that is committed to serving those that are desiring to walk in freedom from addiction. We are looking for additional servants to join this important outreach. Something else that is really cool is NCC is a host church for **Thomasville Prayer Furnace (TPF)**. The vision of this prayer ministry is to create a movement of worship combined with intercession for our community and this region. Included in the vision is to see true spiritual awakening take place that will usher in community transformation for the Kingdom of God. We are privileged to be one of three local churches sharing in the monthly rotation. The first Saturday of each month is set aside for TPF gatherings.

We are changing our **Sunday service time back to 10:30am!** When covid came on the scene it became necessary to make some adjustments and changing our time to 10:00am was important because we were having Sunday morning parking lot services. While we enjoyed worshiping and having church outside, the sun beating down on the team along with the heat, made it difficult to have service during late morning time.
