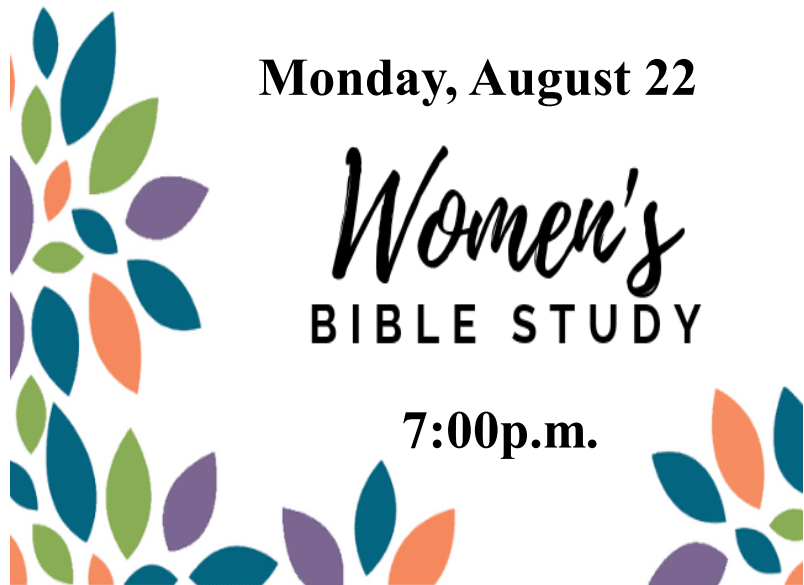

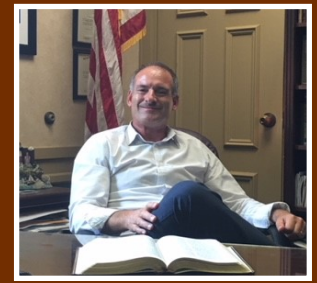

From the Desk of Pastor Dave



I want to first thank Jim Walton for filling in for me by teaching the Wednesday night Bible Class on Stewardship. I heard he did a great job. I also wish to thank Vince Curtis for preaching in my absence on Sunday while we were out of town. His message on Nehemiah was timely and very important as we see the need to be connected to each other in Christ.

We are coming into a new season where it will be important to have a rock solid relationship with Holy Spirit in order to navigate through what's in store for us. If you're not connected it's time to get connected. There's coming a time when we will need to rely on God more and more for direction, and possibly for provision. Whether we're talking about healing, or some other kind of prayer need, we must have Holy Spirit actively involved in our lives.

Our identity is vital so that we will conduct ourselves the way God designed us to. Remember, you are a spiritually, eternal being. Holy Spirit resides in you. Because of this, we must remember that we have a power source that is waiting to be used. This power in the Greek is found in the word *Dunamis*, it's dynamite like power! There are times when we need breakthrough and it takes Holy Spirit to provide it.

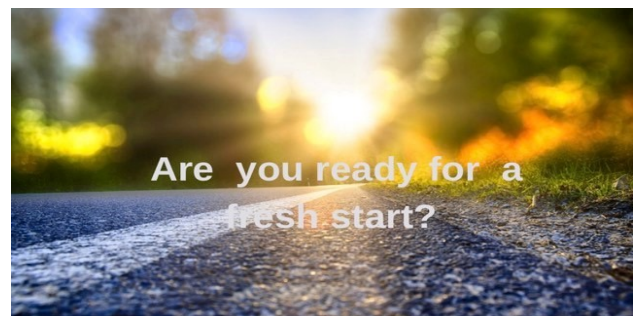
I mentioned that there's three things we must do. Look at these simply truths. The first is, we must stay in Holy Spirit. The second thing is that we must walk in Holy Spirit. Allow Holy Spirit to lead you into victory. Lastly, we must talk in the Spirit. Get the Word of God into your vocabulary. As you read your Bible, allow it to get into your language - speak it, decree it over situations and get comfortable with saying Bible verses out loud. There's something miraculous when you connect with Holy Spirit through the Word of God while activating your faith. As you speak it, get ahold of a picture in your mind of the truth of that Bible verse. The God of breakthrough in your language will become a force against your enemy. The enemy could be depression, fear, lack, sickness, etc. Remember, talking in the Spirit is powerful. Jesus is victorious and we must release our faith and engage Holy Spirit faith. Release authority over your circumstances. Release authority over your destiny. Release authority over the promises of God that you're standing on and waiting to come to pass. When we do all three of these things, we are victorious!
